### **ITALIAN 111-112 (8 or 5\*)—Elementary Italian**

*This course is linked; the second term must be completed to receive any credit toward degree requirements for the first. Limited enrollment.* A course in elementary Italian which emphasizes grammar and the skills of speaking, writing, reading and listening comprehension. *Follo.*

### **★ITALIAN 161-162 (6)—Intermediate Italian**

*Prerequisites: Departmental permission and either Italian 111-112 or the equivalent in language skills. These courses are linked; the second must be completed to receive any credit toward degree requirements for the first.* Continuing Italian, stressing grammar, culture, and the skills of speaking, writing, reading, listening comprehension. *Youngblood.*

### **ITALIAN 401 (1), 402 (2)—Directed Individual Study**

*Prerequisite: Permission of the instructor.* Advanced study in Italian. The nature and content of the course will be determined by the students' needs and by an evaluation of their previous work. May be repeated for degree credit with permission and if the topics are different. *Youngblood.*

*Offered when interest is expressed and departmental resources permit.*

### **★ITALIAN 403 (3)—Directed Individual Study**

*Prerequisite: Permission of the instructor.* Advanced study in Italian. The nature and content of the course will be determined by the students' needs and by an evaluation of their previous work. May be repeated for degree credit with permission and if the topics are different. This course meets the general education requirement in literature only when the subject is literary (area 3). *Youngblood.*
