UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS 101 (1)—Readings in the Humanities

Pass/Fail only. Reading and discussion of primary sources correlated with the current topic of University Scholars 201. May be repeated for degree credit with permission, providing the topics are different.

Winter (second six weeks)

UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS 200 (1)—Independent Seminar

Pass/Fail only. Open only to members of the University Scholars Program with the permission of the Director of the University Scholars Program. Study and discussion of various topics. May be repeated with permission for a maximum of three credits. *Staff.*

Offered when interest is expressed and departmental resources permit.

★UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS 201 (3)—Humanities Seminar

A seminar on a specific topic representing one or more of the humanities. The topic varies from year to year, as does the general education designation. May be repeated for degree credit with permission, providing the topics are different.

★UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS 202 (3 or 4)—Natural Science Seminar

A seminar on a specific topic representing one or more areas in the natural sciences and mathematics. The topic varies from year to year as does the general education designation and number of credits. May be repeated for degree credit with permission, providing the topics are different.

★UNIVERSITY SCHOLARS 203 (3)—Social Science Seminar

A seminar on a specific topic representing one or more areas in the social sciences. The topic varies from year to year as does the general education designation. May be repeated for degree credit with permission, providing the topics are different.
