

**Exchange Between
Washington and Lee University
And
Bates College**

An exchange program between Washington and Lee University and Bates College, was approved, with the stipulation that W&L would not permit a student to take a program that duplicates programs offered at Washington and Lee:

- a. The exchange will be open to sophomores and juniors for one semester, one semester and short term, or one year.
- b. It will be limited to five students in any given semester, but will not be an exchange on a one-for-one basis.
- c. Decisions on exchange students will be made by March 15—prior to decisions on the number of new admits—for the fall semester, and October 15 for the spring semester.
- d. Students must be in good standing, have the endorsement of the Dean of the host institution, and the approval of other agencies such as Off-Campus Study Committees as deemed appropriate by the home institution.
- e. In instances where numbers of candidates exceed the maximum, they will only be allowed on a one-to-one basis.
- f. Credit for study will be determined by the home institution.
- g. Students will be allowed to participate in all extra-curricular activities at the host institution, save intercollegiate athletics.
- h. The student will pay all the fees of the host institution.
- i. Students will be eligible for on-campus residence.
- j. Financial aid arrangements will be the responsibility of the home institution.
